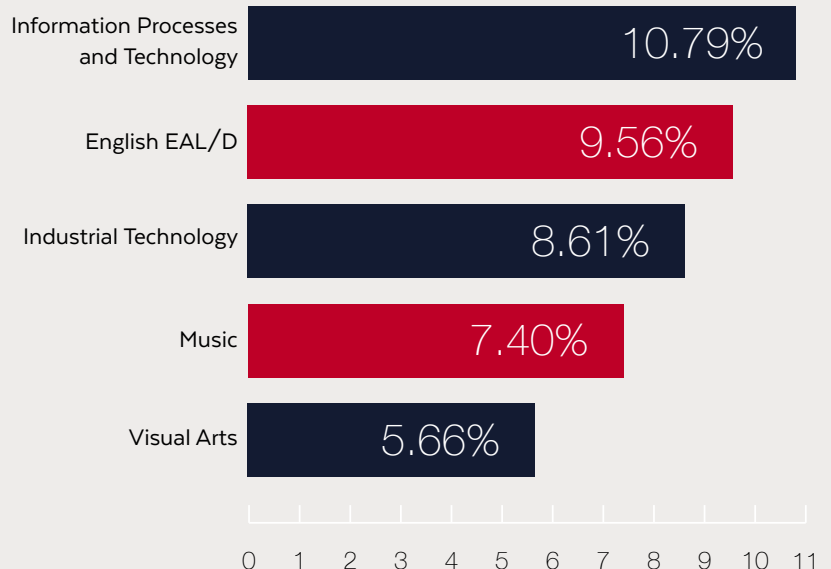
There were 200 Students in Year 12, of which 100% were awarded the HSC. We had 162 students sit the HSC examinations with approximately 870 examination papers completed in 34 different courses of which 75% were above the state average.

Trinity Catholic College students have again performed solidly in the HSC School Certificate. In the 2023 HSC, Trinity students recorded 55 Band 6's or distinguished achievers (scores of 90 or greater).
