HSC Plus Pathway High Achievers (Alternate HSC Pathway)

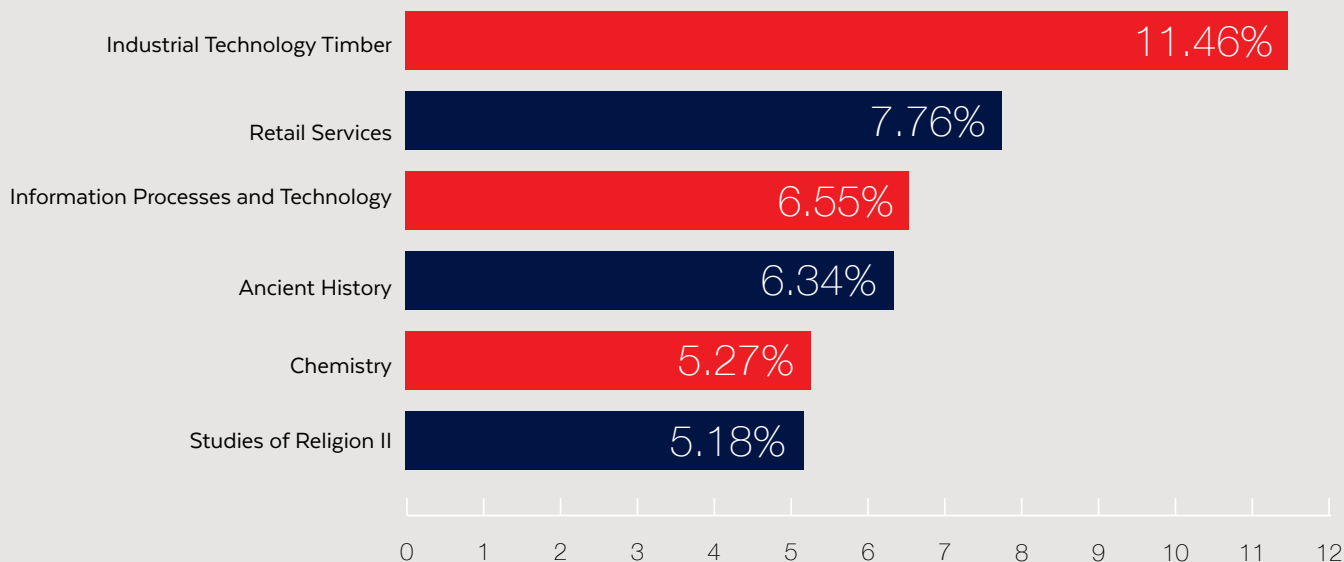
We are very proud of our HSC Plus students who achieved outstanding results as well as gaining industry qualifications and experience as part of their **HSC Plus Pathway**.

There were 205 Students in Year 12, of which 100% were awarded the HSC. We had 157 students sit the HSC examinations with approximately 870 examination papers completed in 36 different courses.

Trinity Catholic College students have again performed solidly in the HSC School Certificate. In the 2024 HSC, Trinity students recorded **67** Band 6's or distinguished achievers (scores of 90 or greater).

80% of students achieved a **Band 4, 5, 6**

41% of students achieved a **Band 5 or 6**

23 Students achieved an ATAR **above 90**

76% of courses achieved **above State Average**
